

Choosing a Self Storage Unit

Picking the kind of self storage unit you need takes some honesty. Be clear with yourself: Do you have a lot of possessions to store? How delicate are they, and how inclined to worry about them will you be while they are packed into the self storage unit? How frequently are you likely to need to go into the self storage unit to take out and put in items? Taking shortcuts or planning for an ideal situation, instead of the situation you are likely to realistically face, is a good way to pick the wrong unit, so plan for reality.

Picking the right size of [self storage](#) unit is essential. Take into account not only the space taken up by your boxed belongings, but any extra space you will need. For example, if you plan to pack the unit, leave everything in it for a period of time, then unpack the entire unit and bring all the objects home, you will need only the space taken up by your belongings themselves. However, if you plan to visit the unit to retrieve objects, treating it like a long term warehouse instead of short term storage, you will need to leave space for aisles so you can reach objects at the back. You may even need garage shelving, both to make finding objects easier and to prevent delicate boxes from being crushed in the stacks.

Choosing the right amount of climate control is also necessary. Many common belongings, like dishes, cooking utensils, and rugs that are not antiques, stone furniture, and most glassware, can withstand most ranges of temperature and do not need temperature control. However, heat damages antiques, art, books, and some textiles. Any objects that contain liquid can burst in a cold snap. Especially delicate items, like some antiques and art, need humidity control as well. When you consider whether you need climate control, take into account what your belongings are made of and how delicate they are. Your peace of mind is also essential. If the condition of your possessions in the self storage unit is likely to weigh on your mind, choosing a unit with climate control may help you put your worries to rest.

Take into account all the factors of your specific case, and make allowances for your comfort as you use the self storage unit. With a little care and realism, you are sure to pick the right kind of self storage unit for you.
